Update definition of New Capacity in Glossary:

New Capacity

means, in respect of the Qualification Process and its associated Capacity Auction, the planned capacity of a new Generator, Generator Unit or Interconnector forming the whole or part of a Capacity Market Unit or proposed Capacity Market Unit, or the incremental increase in the capacity of an existing Generator, Generator Unit or Interconnector forming the whole or part of a Capacity Market Unit or proposed Capacity Market Unit (which has yet to complete Commissioning under the relevant Grid Code), and the planned capacity or incremental increase in capacity of the Capacity Market Unit that comprises them. Where a Demand Site would otherwise be considered New Capacity for the sole reason of a change of its registered Demand Side Unit then it shall be considered Existing Capacity in the determination of the ARHL De-Rating Factor to apply under this Code.
