Explanation of Proposed Change (mandatory by originator)			
<p>This modification proposes to introduce changes to the CMC necessary to support the transition to online Secondary Trading (currently being implemented per approved modification CMC_11_21). Presently, Section M.12.3.2 of the CMC requires that the SOs reject a proposed Alternative Secondary Trade which does not form a matching Trade Pair between Buyer/Seller on the same <u>Working</u> Day.</p> <p>Without this modification, once online Secondary Trading is operational, the SOs (via an automated 24/7 system) would be required to reject all Secondary Trades submitted on weekends. This modification also makes it clearer that trades can be processed up to 23:59 which have formed matching Trade Pairs on the same day. As such, the SOs propose to amend the wording under M.12.3.2 from 'Working' to 'calendar' day which will allow Secondary Trades to be processed 24/7 (at weekends and up to 23:59 on the same day).</p>

M.12 ALTERNATIVE SECONDARY TRADING ARRANGEMENTS M.12.3 Role of System Operators M.12.3.2 The System Operators shall reject a proposed Secondary Trade set out in an Alternative Secondary Trade Notification if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) it does not form part of a matching Trade Pair, where a Trade Pair is formed of matching Alternative Secondary Trade Notifications from Buyer and Seller submitted on the same Working calendar Day; (b) the start of the proposed trade is prior to 5 Working Days after the trade was notified; (c) the end of the proposed trade is at or before its start; (d) the MW quantity of the proposed trade after adjustment pursuant to M.12.2.4 is zero; or (e) it does not comply with the requirements set out in this section M.12. 			
Modification Proposal Justification (Clearly state the reason for the Modification)			

This modification will support the move from manual to online Secondary Trading by introducing changes necessary to facilitate an automated online system.

Code Objectives Furthered

- (a) to facilitate the efficient discharge by EirGrid and SONI of the obligations imposed by their respective Transmission System Operator Licences in relation to the Capacity Market;
- (b) to facilitate the efficient, economic and coordinated operation, administration and development of the Capacity Market and the provision of adequate future capacity in a financially secure manner;
- (g) through the development of the Capacity Market, to promote the short-term and long-term interests of consumers of electricity with respect to price, quality, reliability, and security of supply of electricity across the Island of Ireland.

Implication of not implementing the Modification Proposal

Once online Secondary Trading is fully implemented, the CMC as is will result in Alternative Secondary Trades being rejected by the SOs which were submitted on weekends. Amending the CMC from 'Working' to 'calendar' day will support an automated online system.

Impacts

The system and process changes required to implement online Secondary Trading are already in process. This modification would not introduce additional impacts and would support the changes already being implemented. It is proposed that the effective date of this modification coincide with the operation of online Secondary Trading.

CMC / Code:	means the Capacity Market Code for the Single Electricity Market
Modification Proposal:	means the proposal to modify the Code as set out in the attached form
Derivative Work:	means any text or work which incorporates or contains all or part of the Modification Proposal or any adaptation, abridgement, expansion or other modification of the Modification Proposal

The terms "System Operators" and "Regulatory Authorities" shall have the meanings assigned to those terms in the Code.

In consideration for the right to submit, and have the Modification Proposal assessed in accordance with the terms of Section B.12 of the Code, which I have read and understand, I agree as follows:

1. I hereby grant a worldwide, perpetual, royalty-free, non-exclusive licence:
 - 1.1 to the System Operators and the Regulatory Authorities to publish and/or distribute the Modification Proposal for free and unrestricted access;
