# **Existing Generator Types**

- **☐** Power Producers (above 10MW)
- NFFO Generators
- Independent Generators
- Wheeling Generators
- Micro Generators






## **Generator Options under SEM**

- Participate in the Single Electricity Market
  - Price Maker (requires appropriate metering)
  - ☐ Price Taker (e.g. windfarms who are participating)
- Sell Export Directly to a Supplier (outside the market)
  - ☐ Bilateral Contract (sell 100% energy to a supplier)
  - **Spill Tariff** (where offered by a supplier)

# **Generator Registration**

- Make Commercial Arrangement with Supplier
  - Bilateral Contract
  - **□** Spill Tariff
- Supplier sends market message (N010) to NIE T&D to register Import
- Supplier sends Pro-Forma to NIE T&D to nominate Export (found in Retail Market Procedure NI 109)





## **Generator Registration**

- Market Procedure MP NI 109
  - Register for Transmission Rebate
  - Register for Export
- Information Required:-
- Supplier Name, Address and Contact Details
- Supplier Unit to which export will be aggregated
- Generation Site MPRN
- Generation Site Name and Address
- Generation Site Connection Voltage
- Effective Date of Start of Nomination (for new nominations only)
- Effective Date of Termination of Nomination (for terminations of existing nominations)





## Reporting

- Suppliers receive:-
  - N341 Market Message containing Import and Export for all their HH sites
  - □ CSV report containing Import and Export for all their sites
  - Settlement Statements
- Generators receive:-
  - □ CSV report containing Import and Export for each site as a separate file
  - □ Generators need to inform us if they require this





## **Outstanding Issues**

#### Key Generators

- A concept requested by suppliers so that HH data for generators above a certain threshold would be submitted by D+4.

#### Micro Generators (Interval Metered)

- Some HH Domestic Customers exist in the market. Billed as NHH Customers. These need to be billed as HH Customers in the future.

#### ■ Demand Side Units (with Generators on site)

- Supplier has site to be registered as part of DSU and can reduce load by activating generator on site.

#### Transmission Rebate

- Determination as to which generators are entitled
