- To accede to the Market: Party Registration
- To participate in the Market: Unit Registration
- The Trading & Settlement Code obliges all Generators with a Maximum Export Capacity $\geq 10\text{MW}$ to be registered for SEM (De Minimis Participant 2.14B)
- Generators $< 10\text{MW}$ may choose to register or not for the SEM
- No De Minimis Threshold for Suppliers

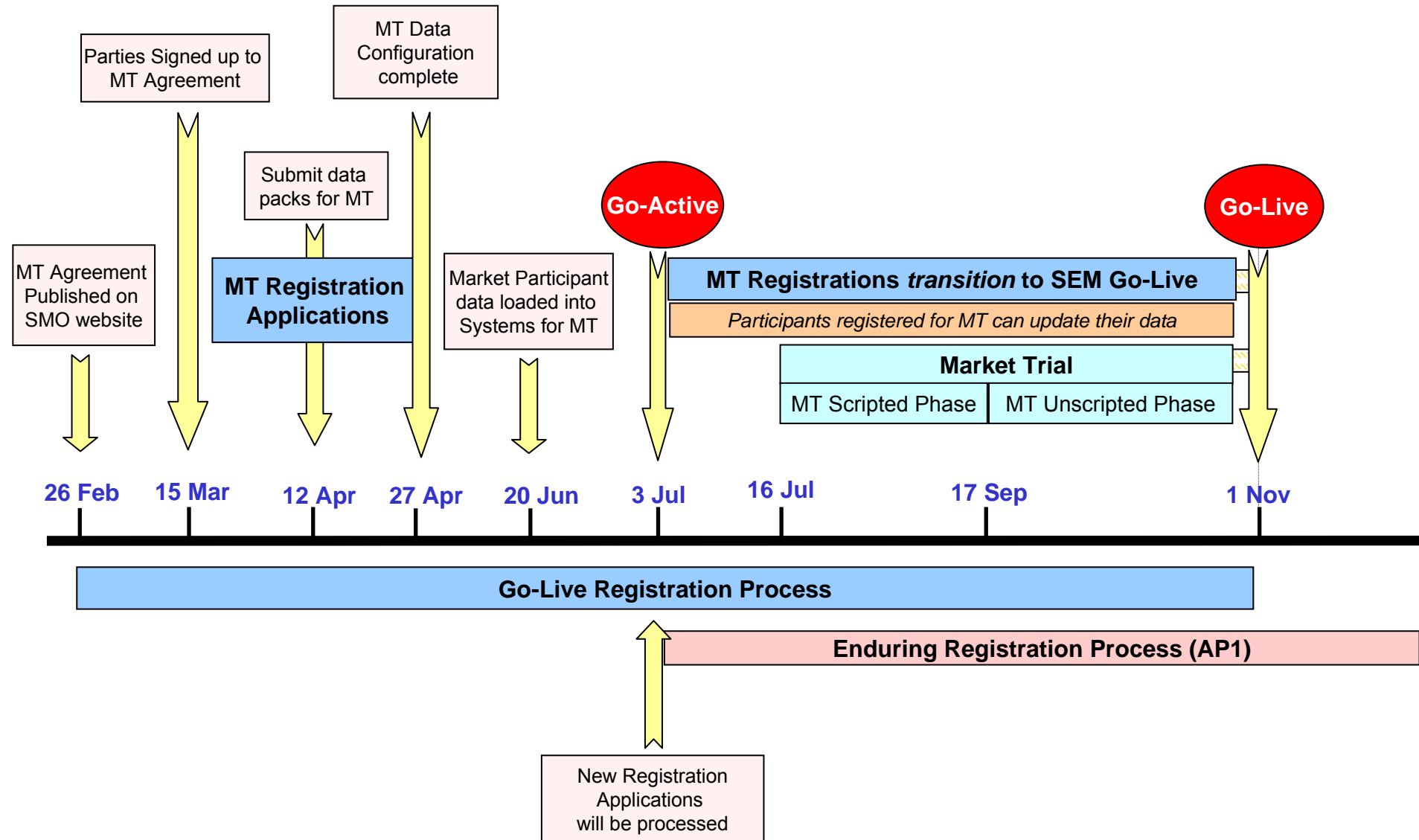
2 Main Processes for Registration for SEM

1. Go-Live Registration Process encompasses:

- Market Trial Registration (Feb-April)
 - » The Participant Registration process for Market Trial is a scaled down, simplified process.
 - » Market Trial gives participants who want to trade from 01-Nov an opportunity to bed-down operations prior to SEM Go-Live
 - » A rehearsal for people, processes and systems
- Transitional Registration (July-Oct)

2. Enduring Registration:

- Trading and Settlement code comes into play



- New Parties wishing to participate in the SEM must follow the ‘enduring’ process
- Applications accepted from the Code ‘Go-Active’ date (3rd July).
 - Will be processed according to Agreed Procedure (AP1)
- AP1 “Participant and Unit Registration & Deregistration”
 - sets out detailed registration process and associated obligations, timelines and data requirements .
 - process and timings in AP1 currently being finalised.
 - consultation drafts of AP’s issued 16th May.
 - publication of AP’s in line with v 2.0 of Code: 4th June.

- Read and understand Registration requirements and process in AP1 as currently drafted
- Consultation on AP1 will be commencing shortly
