Cut Over Grid Code Section

- CO.1 In relation to the **Cut Over Period** only, the following paragraphs shall apply. They supplement the other **Grid Code** provisions and insofar as they are inconsistent, these provisions shall prevail.
- CO.2 For the **Cut Over Period**, both the **Old Grid Code** and the **New Grid Code** will be in force, to the extent provided for in this **Cut Over Grid Code** Section.
- CO.3 The **New Grid Code** will, save as provided in this **Cut Over Grid Code** Section, come into force and replace the **Old Grid Code** at 00.00 hours on 1 November 2007, which moment of time shall be known as the **Cut Over Time**. Such replacement will be without prejudice to those rights and obligations accrued under the **Old Grid Code**.
- CO.4 For the **Cut Over Period**, the following paragraphs apply in respect of the **Scheduling and Dispatch Codes**:
- CO.4.1 In respect of the **Scheduling** process for the **Schedule Day** ending at 24.00 hours on 31 October 2007, the preparation of the **Indicative Running Notification** by the **TSO** and the submission of information by **Users** to enable the compilation and updating of that **Indicative Running Notification** will be governed by the **Scheduling and Dispatch Codes** of the **Old Grid Code**.
- CO.4.2 In respect of the Scheduling process for the 6-hour period starting at the Cut Over Time, the preparation of the Indicative Operations Schedule by the TSO and the submission of information by Users to enable the compilation and updating of the Indicative Operations Schedule shall be governed by the Scheduling and Dispatch Codes of the New Grid Code. Therefore, by 10.00 hours on 30 October 2007, Users will need to submit information under the Old Grid Code and the New Grid Code. In addition, to ensure continuity of data in the period leading to the first Trading Day on 1 November 2007, Users shall also be required to submit information under SDC1 of the New Grid Code in respect of the period from 06:00 hours to 24.00 hours on 31 October 2007 as if the New Grid Code already applied, which must be consistent with the data published for such period under the Old Grid Code.
- OC.4.3 In respect of the **Scheduling** process for the **Trading Day** beginning at 06.00 hours on 1 November 2007, the preparation of the **Indicative Operations Schedule** by the **TSO** and the submission of information by **Users** to enable the compilation and updating of that **Indicative Operations Schedule** shall be governed by the **Scheduling and Dispatch Codes** of the **New Grid Code** and the submission of information to **Users** will need to be undertaken by 10.00 hours on 31 October 2007.
- CO.4.4 The issue of **Dispatch Instructions** by the **TSO** for the **Dispatch** of plant in respect of the period up to the **Cut Over Time** will be governed by the **Scheduling and Dispatch Codes** of the **Old Grid Code**.
- CO.4.5 The issue of **Dispatch Instructions** by the **TSO** for the **Dispatch** of plant in respect of the period following the **Cut Over Time** shall be governed by the **Scheduling and Dispatch Codes** in the **New Grid Code**.
- CO.4.6 A **Dispatch Instruction** issued in respect of the period up to the **Cut Over Time**, will if the instruction requires the plant to continue to operate at the same level and in the same manner after the **Cut Over Time**, be deemed to be a **Dispatch Instruction** issued under the **New Grid Code** in respect of the period following the **Cut Over Time**. The **TSO** may also in the period prior to the **Cut Over Time**, give a **Dispatch Instruction** to a **User** in respect of a **Trading**

Period after the **Cut Over Time** and this will be deemed to be a **Dispatch Instruction** issued under the **New Grid Code** in respect of the period following the **Cut Over Time**.

- CO.4.7 This paragraph shall apply where the **Scheduling and Dispatch Codes** of the **New Grid Code** allow for data submitted under the **SEM TSC** to be deemed to have been submitted under the **Scheduling and Dispatch Codes** of the **New Grid Code**. Any data which is submitted under the **SEM TSC** prior to the start of the **Cut Over Period**, shall be deemed, for the purposes of the **New Grid Code**, to have been submitted at the start of the **Cut Over Period**.
- CO.4.8 References in other documents to an obligation to comply with "the **Grid Code**" shall, in respect of the **Cut Over Period**, be read as an obligation to comply with the **Old Grid Code** and/or the **New Grid Code** where applicable.

Definitions

Cut Over Period: The period from 00.00 hours on 30 October to 12.00 hours on 2 November 2007.

Cut Over Time: 00.00 hours on 1 November 2007, as specified in CO.3

Old Grid Code: The version of the NIE Grid Code which applies up until the end of the Cut Over Period.

New Grid Code: The version of the SONI **Grid Code**, as amended for the **SEM** and the IME Directive, which applies as from the start of the **Cut Over Period** onwards.
