1. Approval and adoption of the agenda

Gordon Downie updated the Committee on the Appeal Panel decision. The Committee discussed implications of the appeal outcome and next steps including a Judicial Review and confirmed its commitment to ISEM 1 October go-live date. 4. ISEM/DS3 project updates

5. DS3 system services volume capped procurement arrangements

Robert O'Rourke updated the Committee on the Transmission System Operator's DS3 system services volume capped recommendations proposals including service provider requirements, procurement approach, bidder selection and remuneration, market interactions and obligations. The Committee further discussed product characteristics, network limitations, signals for new market entrants, timing and next steps.

SEMC noted the ongoing discussions with a decision on the consultation to come to the August SEMC.
